



PALAIS THEATRE COMMUNITY FUND

Frequently asked questions:

Who is eligible to apply?

The Palais Theatre Community Fund is open to charities and not-for-profit organisations who are registered with the Australian Charities and Not-For-Profit Commission (ACNC). The project must be in St Kilda or the wider City of Port Phillip and benefit the City of Port Phillip residents.

If you are an individual or unincorporated organisation you may be able to seek funding from the Palais Theatre Community Fund by using an auspice, provided the project meets all the other eligibility requirements.

Do I need Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) status?

You do not need to have DGR status to be eligible for funding. If you do have DGR status we request that you provide your DGR number in your application.

What kinds of things can be funded?

The Palais Theatre Community Fund can support the following:

- Infrastructure
- Equipment
- Community programs and initiatives, particularly those that encourage community connection and participation
- Creative arts projects and initiatives, including (but not limited to) events, internships and educational courses

What is not eligible for funding?

- Ongoing operational costs
- Projects that have already commenced or been completed

The Palais Theatre Community Fund only offers one off funding, therefore is unable to fund ongoing or recurring expenses such as operational expenses.

How do I apply?

Your application must be lodged through our online Survey Monkey form.

How much can I apply for?

The Palais Theatre Community Fund offers grants of up to \$5000.





How are applications assessed?

The applications are assessed by the Palais Theatre Community Fund Committee. This committee is made up of four City of Port Phillip community representatives appointed by both the Palais Theatre and City of Port Phillip.

If I am successful, how do I get the funds?

If your application is successful, you will be required to enter into an agreement with Live Nation and provide your nominated bank account details. Once all the paper work is filled out, the funds will be deposited direct into your account.

Where does the money come from?

Live Nation Australia, a Live Nation Entertainment company, established the Palais Theatre Community Fund, a new community grants program in partnership with the City of Port Phillip, established to provide long-term benefits to residents of St Kilda and City of Port Phillip community.

The Palais Theatre Community Fund is funded via a 50-cent donation from Live Nation for every ticket sold for an event at the Palais Theatre.
